#### **CHEMO CARE BAG PROJECT**

The Hosanna Women attending the "Walking in Love" Retreat in January will prepare 100 Care Bags chemotherapy patients at the St. Cancer Center Tammany and Ochsners at St. Tammany Cancer Center. The Quilters have donated fabric for the bags and people are volunteering to help sew. We are applying for a \$250 grant from Thrivent Financial which will purchase additional fabric and some of the items needed to fill the bags including fleece blankets and devotionals.

We are also inviting the congregation to assist with this project by donating items to go in the bags (see list below) and/or funds to offset their cost. It is estimated that it will cost \$15-\$20 to fill each bag. Checks and items can be dropped off at the Info Center any time between now and Sunday, January 22nd.
