## Thank You

Thank you to the members of Hosanna who contributed to the recent Care Bag Project for Chemotherapy patients at St. Tammany Cancer Center. Eighty three bags were filled at the Women's Retreat and another 17 are in the process of being sewn and/or filled. The \$250 seed money from Thrivent Financial for Christians helped start this project of generosity. Our Quilters donated most of the fabric for the bags and eight ladies contributed their time to sewing the handmade bags. Over \$300 was collected along with lotion, blankets, journals, pens, lip balm, cozy socks and scarves. Twenty five of these bags have already been given to the Cancer Center at St. Tammany and will be given to patients at both Ochsner and Mary Bird Perkins. Over time, as they need them, the remainder of the bags will be taken there as well. Their storage facilities are limited, so for now, our guest room closet is a bit full. The Bible says we are blessed to be a blessing. Hosanna has once again followed these words and shared God's blessings with others.

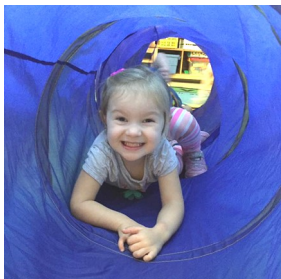
